Papier Mache Angel



## Materials needed

Frame. 11"x14" – Style of choice  
Artist's Loft™ Canvas Board, 11"x14"  
Liquitex® Gesso – White  
Liquitex® Gel Medium  
Liquitex® Soft Body Acrylic Paint – Burnt Umber  
Darice® Paper Mache – Mannequin  
Cheese Cloth  
24ga Wire – Silver  
Scrap Newspaper  
Stylist  
Scissors  
Paintbrush  
Paper Towels  
Paper Palette  
Low Heat Glue Gun

## Instructions

1. Paint frame with white gesso, let dry.
2. Very lightly dry brush with burnt umber. Remember you can always add more color if desired.
3. Paint canvas with white gesso, let dry.
4. Add some torn pieces of newspaper to canvas using gel medium as glue.
5. Add second coat of gesso to canvas, while wet use stylist to write words as desired onto canvas, let dry.
6. Dry brush burnt umber onto canvas.
7. Paint mannequin with white gesso, let dry.
8. Use gel medium to add cheese cloth to mannequin draping as you go. Let dry.
9. Form wings with wire, add cheese cloth to wings using the gel medium as glue and let dry.
10. Glue wings to back of mannequin.
11. Glue mannequin to canvas.
12. Add to frame.
